

Since the presentation in Rome (June 2011) the WNetXL system has received an unpredictable approval by the international community from both academic and professional side.

The latest demonstration comes from Norway, where **SINTEF** decided to use the WNetXL system in a project pertaining the analysis and management of the water distribution network in Oslo.
